



NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR ENERGUIDE FOR HOUSES PROGRAM

Newfoundland and Labrador's EnerGuide for Houses Program helps homeowners make their homes more energy-efficient and reduce the burden of high energy costs. Eligible upgrades include wood heating systems. Appliances purchased must meet certain requirements. Those requirements can be summarized as follows:

APPLIANCE TYPE	REQUIREMENTS
Wood stove, fireplace or insert	Certified to EPA or CSAB415.1
Wood furnace	Certified to EPA or CSAB415.1

Grants offered under the program can be summarized as follows for each appliance type:

APPLIANCE TYPE	GRANT
Wood stove, fireplace or insert	375\$
Wood furnace	375\$

Qualifying models:

The following PSG models qualify for Newfoundland and Labrador's EnerGuide for Houses Program:

Caddy Wood and Wood-Electric Combination Furnace
Mini-Caddy Wood and Wood-Electric Combination Furnace
Max Caddy Wood and Wood-Electric Combination Furnace

Important notes:

All participants require a home energy evaluation prior to any work commencing. An energy advisor from one of the qualifying service organizations must perform the evaluation. The advisor chosen will return and verify the work completed. The following organizations are certified to deliver home energy evaluations:
